### Old Business:

Discussed Tiger Cards are coming, decided to order 1500, submitting to the printer this week.

### New Business:

\*Tag Day: No Contact Method - Students will be given door hanger envelopes on 8/3. They distribute to houses on their assigned street (s) on 8/5, students return to pick up on 8/8. No earlier than 10 am. Students will not be knocking on any doors. Students will then bring their collections to Victory Park for a drive by drop off. On envelopes, neighbors can put a stamp on the envelope and mail, hang on their door, or bring to Victory Park for a drive by drop off.

\*Opt out: If you choose to opt out of the restaurant fundraising, it's \$100. Selling 2 Tiger Cards is still mandatory. But, we are requesting that students please still participate in Tag Day. This heavily relies on manpower.

### Budget Updates:

\*Expenditures: Tents for \$4,000, this is a pandemic expense, not typical.

\*Booster fees are \$185 (We had balanced our budget based on \$185, not \$180 as accidentally stated last month)
