## Director:

- Trip Itinerary will be posted after the meeting.
  - 1. Practices will be after school 3-5. If there is a sport conflict, the request is that the student be equitable in their time split between the sport and band. Practices are spread out and not every day.
    - \*Guard and percussion are asked to be at the posted practices as well as they will have additional practices determined by their director. Those dates should be communicated from them.
  - 2. Chaperones
    - Ration will be 1:10 to 1:12

- 3. Packing lists will come, requested to bring a package of masks as we will need to mask at all indoor public places.
